- Some toys or towels that will make your buns feel at home.
- Any special food.
- Your veterinarian's name and number.
- Your emergency contact information
- Any specific information on your animal(s)' medical conditions, if any.
- Information on your rabbit(s)' preferred feeding schedule, including quantities and any restrictions.
- If you don't use carefresh litter, please bring the litter that you prefer.
